### SUMMER IS FOR SERVICE AND FITNESS

A wonderful summer program sponsored by Cataldo (but offered to anyone who is interested) for students currently in 5th grade to students who are going into high school to focus on service opportunities, fitness and mini-workshops that help students plan for their future. The program will start the week of June 20th and end the last week of July. Tuesdays and Thursdays are service days and start at 9:00 and end at noon. Wednesdays are our fitness days and will meet at the same time as service. The combination of these two programs will help students stay active and fit and learn about the different ways students can help other people and do God's work. Some Service programs we have planned are volunteering at Blessings under the Bridge, Second Harvest Food Bank, ARC of Spokane and many more opportunities. Some fitness activities would include bowling, hiking, tennis and many more. Calendars of the events will be out the end of May. The leaders are Janet Maucione and Mitch Weller. The limit of students each day is 15 so get your name in first so you have first opportunity to sign up. The cost is \$20 per week, no matter how many days the student participates. ### Blue Envelope Fund

Where does the money go?

For many years Sacred Heart Parish has provided emergency assistance funds to Martin Luther King Center (MLK) for persons in need in our neighborhood. A family advocate at MLK determines income eligibility, need, and a criteria that the family lives in the 99202 area and has a child under 18 years of age in the home. If rent or utility assistance is needed Sacred Heart Parish is contacted and our Parish will send a check directly to the landlord or utility company up to \$75 to help stabilize the family. Sacred Heart Parish assists between 5-7 families per month and limits MLK to a total of \$500 per month. Families are eligible for assistance once per year. If our Parish office gets a request for emergency assistance the individual is referred to MLK.

In addition to our emergency assistance funds to MLK, Sacred Heart Parish Blue Envelope Fund also provides a monthly contribution of \$100. to Meals on Wheels and Transitions - Women's Hearth (a downtown day center for women in need).
